
- Increase the quality and appeal of vocational training (VET) and lifelong learning

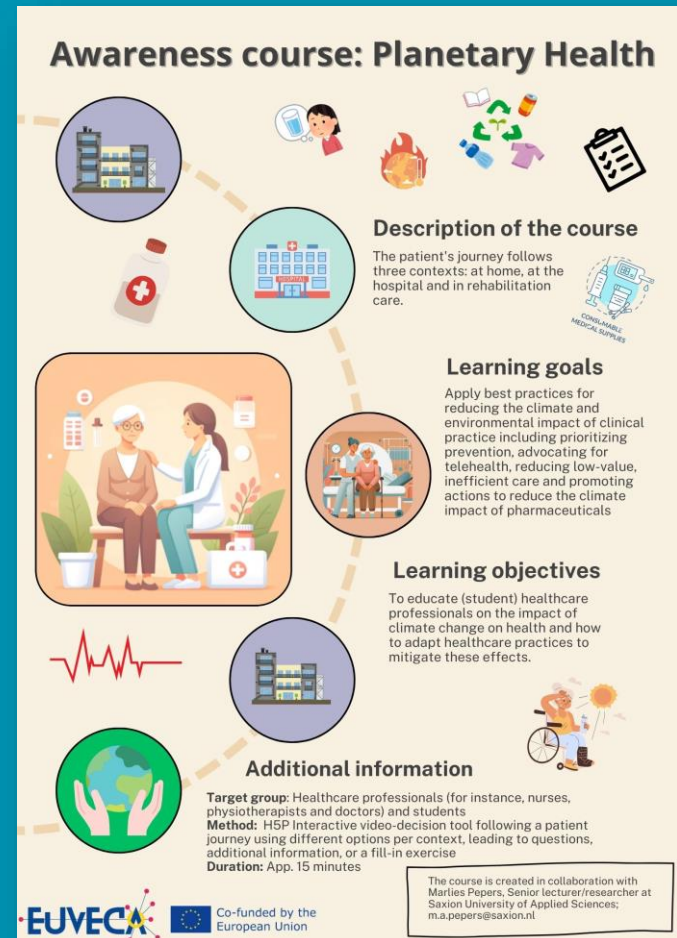
